Provisions for medical gases, power, information systems, monitoring, and critical equipment storage are located here. A hospital must determine which mode will deliver these services: a headwall system (pre-manufactured or built-in), a power column, or an articulated-arm boom. Pre-manufactured or built-in headwalls are most common in lower-acuity and multi-acuity settings and are the least expensive. The proposed highest acuity level will determine the number of each outlet type. There must also be lighting for patient examinations, patient reading, and ambient settings.
