



Background

Pursuant to the Group Purchasing Code of Conduct, Premier Healthcare Solutions, Inc. and Premier Healthcare Alliance, L.P. ("Premier"), are required to disclose to members any non-Group Purchasing Organization (GPO) business relationships which Premier maintains with Participating Vendors. A Participating Vendor is a vendor that has a contract, or submits a formal bid or offer to contract, to provide goods or services to members.

Business relationships include the sale of Premier products and services to Participating Vendors or any other type of arrangement where money flows from Participating Vendors to Premier or their subsidiaries. This list does not include business relationships that exist to purchase goods and services that are utilized by the organization to carry out its general business operations so long as the terms of the arrangements reflect fair market value for the goods being purchased (e.g., Premier may utilize rental cars or purchase computer equipment from vendors that are also Participating Vendors). These relationships have no bearing on GPO contracting decisions. Participating Vendors may also provide funds to Premier to purchase exhibition/booth space at Premier's national meetings. These fees are designed to cover actual costs of the exhibition/booth space and other meeting costs.
